J		All optical scan absentee ballots have been accounted for and properly scanned, excluding any challenged ballots, and the results have been imported into the Election Results Manager (ERM).
J		All PEBs, or other media, from the in-office absentee/fail-safe voting machine(s) have been read into ERM; and any challenged ballots have been excluded.
J		All PEBs from all precincts have been read into ERM.
	J	All optical scan emergency ballots have been located and properly scanned, and the results have been imported into ERM.
	J	All non-optical scan paper ballots cast at a polling place have been located and counted, and the results have been manually entered into ERM in the proper precincts. <i>Note: When manually entering vote totals, ballots cast figures must also be manually updated. See Election Preparation & Results Accumulation Guide (EPRAG).</i>
	J	All optical scan ballots rejected by the scanner have been duplicated and scanned, attaching the duplicates to the originals, and the results have been imported into ERM; or the ballots have been counted by hand and manually entered into ERM. <i>Note: When manually entering vote totals, ballots cast figures must also be manually updated. See EPRAG.</i>
J		All ballot boxes have been opened and thoroughly checked for any paper ballots cast at polling places.
J		All precinct-level PEB results uploaded to ERM have been checked against the precinct level paper tape results.
J		The Managers Return of Paper Ballots form has been examined; and the number of emergency and provisional ballots cast at the polls has been reconciled with the number of emergency ballots counted, and the number of provisional ballots considered at the provisional ballot hearing.
	J	All optical scan provisional ballots found to be valid at the provisional ballot hearing have been properly scanned, and the results imported into ERM in the provisional precinct; or the ballots have been counted by hand, and the results manually entered into ERM. <i>Note: When manually entering vote totals, ballots cast figures must also be manually updated. See EPRAG.</i>
	J	All provisional ballots cast on the in-office absentee/fail-safe voting machine that were originally excluded when the PEBs were read, but have now been found to be valid, have been added to the proper precinct in ERM.
J		All election data, including flash card audit data, has been uploaded into ERM and securely saved to a CD for required 22-month retention period (<i>see EPRAG</i>).
J		The above steps were done in accordance with the applicable procedures set forth in the latest version of the EPRAG.
